An Act

To designate the Cleveland Ohio General Mail Facility and Main Office in Cleveland, Ohio, as the "John O. Holly Building of the United States Postal Service".

June 24, 1988
[H.R. 4448]

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That the building located at 2400 Orange Avenue, Cleveland, Ohio, known as the Cleveland Ohio General Mail Facility and Main Office is designated as the "John O. Holly Building of the United States Postal Service". Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document, record, or other paper of the United States to that building shall be deemed to be a reference to the John O. Holly Building of the United States Postal Service.

SEC. 2. DESIGNATION OF GRANITE REEF AQUEDUCT AS THE "HAYDEN-RHODES AQUEDUCT".

(a) The Granite Reef Aqueduct of the Central Arizona project, constructed, operated, and maintained under section 301(a)(1) of the Colorado River Basin Act (43 U.S.C. 1521(a)(1)), hereafter shall be known and designated as the "Hayden-Rhodes Aqueduct".

(b) Any reference in any law, regulation, document, record, map, or other paper of the United States to the aqueduct referred to in subsection (a) hereby is deemed to be a reference to the "Hayden-Rhodes Aqueduct".
