An Act

To increase the amount authorized to be appropriated for acquisition at the
Women's Rights National Historical Park.

Oct. 6, 1988
[H.R. 2952]

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the
United States of America in Congress assembled,*

SECTION 1. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS FOR ACQUISITION.

Subsection (i) of section 1601 of the Act entitled "An Act to provide, with respect to the national park system: for the establishment of new units; for adjustments in boundaries; for increases in appropriation authorizations for land acquisition and development; and for other purposes" (16 U.S.C. 4101l(i)) is amended by striking out "\$490,000" and inserting in lieu thereof "\$700,000".
