To amend title 5 of the United States Code to increase the allowance for services of attendants.

Attendant Allowance Adjustment Act. 5 USC 8101 note. Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

This Act may be cited as the "Attendant Allowance Adjustment Act".

SEC. 2. INCREASE IN AMOUNT.

Subsection (a) of section 8111 of title 5, United States Code is amended by striking out "\$500" and inserting in lieu thereof "\$1,500".

SEC. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.

The amendment made by section 2 shall take effect October 1, 1990.
